OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed July 1, 1981, the General Telephone Company of the Midwest, Columbus, Nebraska, seeks authority to add rates for a one-time Tier A payment for the 17A Key System.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference are copies of the following proposed tariff sheets:

First Revised Sheets 8-11, Section XII

Applicant seeks authority to establish rates for a one-time Tier A payment for items associated with the 17A Key System. Regular Tier B monthly rates would continue to apply.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-160 be and it is hereby granted and the General Telephone Company of the Midwest, Columbus, Nebraska be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.
