OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed July 1, 1981, the General Telephone Company of the Midwest, Columbus, Nebraska, seeks authority to offer the GTE 60 XF and Remote Signalling for universal night answer option.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference are copies of the following proposed tariff sheets:

Eleventh Revised Sheet 10, Index
Fifth Revised Sheet B, Section XI
First Revised Sheets 92-99, Section XI
Original Sheets 100-108, Section XI

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to indicate that the Automatic Electric GTE 60 PABX is no longer manufactured and is not available to new customers. In its place applicant propose to offer the GTE 60 XF PABX which provides additional features. It is also proposed to offer a new optional feature for both systems, Remote Signalling for Universal Night Answer.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-162 be and it is hereby granted and the General Telephone Company of the Midwest be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file appropriate tariff sheets with the Commission.
