OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed July 16, 1981, the General Telephone Company of the Midwest, Columbus, Nebraska, seeks authority to discontinue service station rates and revise provisions regarding multi-party, four-party and two-party service.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference are copies of the following proposed tariff sheets:

Ninth Revised Sheet 12, Index
Twenty-third Revised Sheet E, Section I
Twenty-sixth Revised Sheet F, Section I
Seventh Revised Sheet 1, Section III
First Revised Sheet 15, Section III

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to indicate that service station service is no longer provided and that multi-party rural business and residence service, urban party line residence service and urban residence four party service are no longer offered to new customers in any exchange. Urban residence two party service is also no longer offered to new customers in any exchange except Columbus and Kearney.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-164 be and it is hereby granted and the General Telephone Company of the Midwest be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.
