Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to indicate that the PagePac Loudspeaker Paging Service is obsolete and will no longer be offered to new customers. Applicant proposes a new offering of PagePac Voice Paging Systems under the Variable Term Payment Plan.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.
