OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed August 18, 1981, Roland E. Schatz, Grand Island, Nebraska, seeks a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity within a radius of 35 miles from Lincoln, Nebraska.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. Protests to the application were filed by The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company and Nebraska Radio Telephone System.

Hearing was scheduled on the application on March 3, 1982. On February 17, 1982, applicant requested authority to withdraw his application.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application be dismissed at applicant's request.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-178 be and it is hereby dismissed at applicant's request.
