OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed August 20, 1981, the General Telephone Company of the Midwest, Columbus, Nebraska, seeks authority to change its offering of Hands Free Answerback Feature and 17A Key Telephones.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff relating to the 17A Key System to discontinue, as a separate offering, the Hands Free Answerback Feature. All new 17A Key Telephones will be equipped with the Hands Free Answer back Feature at the same rates as telephones equipped with the feature in the present tariff.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-179 be and it is hereby granted and the General Telephone Company of the Midwest be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file appropriate tariff sheets with the Commission.
