### OPINION AND FINDINGS

#### BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed August 26, 1981, the Northeast Nebraska Telephone Company, Jackson, Nebraska, seeks approval to construct, operate and maintain IMTS and paging service from its Clearwater exchange and to establish tariffs therefor.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Applicant seeks to offer mobile telephone and paging service at its Clearwater exchange. Rates proposed are:
