OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed September 8, 1981, the General Telephone Company of the Midwest, Columbus, Nebraska, seeks authority to revise its General Rules and Regulations regarding interest on deposits.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to increase to 7% the interest paid on deposits, in conformance with the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.
