OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed September 23, 1981, the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska, seeks approval of a tariff sheet of its Local Exchange Tariff.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference is a copy of the following proposed tariff sheet:

Eighth Revised Sheet 5, Local Exchange Tariff

Applicant proposes to revise its tariff to reflect the offering of extended area service between its Omaha, Nebraska exchange and its Crescent and Underwood, Iowa exchanges and the Treynor, Iowa exchange of Central Telephone Company. No increase in rates is proposed for Nebraska subscribers.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-185 be and it is hereby granted and the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file an appropriate tariff sheet with the Commission.
