OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed October 13, 1981, Tracy Corporation dba KMOR, Scottsbluff, Nebraska, seeks authority to provide radio common carrier service at Scottsbluff, Nebraska.

Protest to the application was filed by United Telephone Company of the West.

On December 15, 1981, applicant submitted a Motion for Production of Documents and Information, with motion was granted on December 22, 1981.

Protestant furnished information to applicant by letter dated December 31, 1981. On January 5, 1982, applicant filed a motion to force compliance with the Commission order of December 22, 1981. Oral argument on said motion was held on January 12, 1982.

Upon consideration of the application, the motion and arguments of counsel, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the motion should be overruled.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Motion to Force Compliance in C-187 be and it is hereby overruled.
