OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed October 15, 1981, the Hamilton Telephone Company, Aurora, Nebraska, seeks authority to amend its General Exchange Tariff to provide revised procedures and rate schedules regarding its telephone service and service connection charges.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference are copies of the following proposed tariff sheets:

Sheet 2, Pages 1 and 2, Section B

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to offer Custom Calling Features at its Aurora exchange including Speed Calling, Three-way Calling, Call Forwarding and Call Waiting. Rates proposed are \$2.50 for installation and \$1.50 per month for each feature except 20 number speed calling which is \$3.00 per month. Customers may also subscribe to combinations of three or four features.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-188 be and it is hereby granted and the Hamilton Telephone Company be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file appropriate tariff sheets with the Commission.
