OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed October 19, 1981, the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska, seeks approval of tariff sheets of its Intrastate Private Line Tariff.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. A protest to the application was filed by the Federal Executive Agencies.

Public hearing scheduled on the application was continued several times at the request of the parties and finally cancelled when the protest was withdrawn after applicant amended its proposed tariff.

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff relating to the offering of Telpak service. Applicant had originally proposed to obsolete the Telpak offering and to withdraw the service two years after Commission approval. Applicant has amended its proposed tariff to obsolete the service but continue to offer it to existing customers. The service will not be withdrawn.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.
