OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed October 29, 1981, Donald C. Mickels, Madrid, Nebraska, seeks authority to receive telephone service from the Elsie exchange of Elsie Mutual Telephone Company.

Copies of the application were served upon Elsie Mutual Telephone Company and Chrisp's Telephone Company.

Applicant is an individual residing within the Madrid, Nebraska exchange of Chrisp's Telephone Company who desires telephone service from the Elsie exchange of Elsie Mutual Telephone Company.

Chrisp's Telephone Company has advised the Commission in writing that it is agreeable to the application and Elsie Mutual Telephone Company has indicated in writing that it is willing to provide service to the applicant.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is agreeable to all parties concerned, will not create a duplication of facilities, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-193 be and it is hereby granted and Donald C. Mickels be and he is hereby authorized to receive telephone service from the Elsie exchange of the Elsie Mutual Telephone Company.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Elsie Mutual Telephone Company and Chrisp's Telephone Company file with this Commission revised boundary maps reflecting the change in exchange service areas authorized herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be and it is hereby made the Commission's Official Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for Elsie Mutual Telephone Company to serve applicant herein.
