OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed November 19, 1981, the Wauneta Telephone Company, Benkelman, Nebraska, seeks authority to implement mobile roamer tariffs.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference is a copy of the proposed tariff sheet.

Applicant seeks to establish rates and tariffs for Mobile Telephone "Roamer" Service, that is persons who are subscribers to Mobile Telephone Service of other telephone companies. Rates proposed are 25¢ per message and 20¢ per minute for calls to land line phones and 40¢ per minute for calls to other mobile phones.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-199 be and it is hereby granted and the Wauneta Telephone Company be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.
