OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed November 24, 1981, the United Telephone Company of the West, Scottsbluff, Nebraska, seeks authority to file additional exceptions relating to voice recorders having to use the fifteen second recorder tone.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff relating to connections with customer provided voice recording equipment to establish additional exceptions to the tone warning requirement for calls made to fire or police service, emergency service numbers, calls made for unlawful purposes, recordings made pursuant to court order and for private line service not connected to the exchange system.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-201 be and it is hereby granted and the United Telephone Company of the West be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file appropriate tariff sheets with the Commission.
