OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed November 30, 1981, the General Telephone Company of the Midwest, Columbus, Nebraska, seeks authority to remove from its tariff certain equipment not in service and obsolete.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

ORDER
