OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed December 4, 1981, the Western Union Telegraph Company, Upper Saddle River, New Jersey, seeks authority to revise certain pages of its Tariff N.P.S.C. No. 1.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Pursuant to notice required by law, Public Hearing was held on the application on February 2, 1982 at 8:00 a.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln, Nebraska.

Applicant seeks to restructure and increase Public Message Service rates and to increase InfoMaster Service rates for messages filed from Telex I and II (TWX) terminals. The rates proposed are the same as those filed with the Federal Communications Commission and in effect for interstate service.

The new rates are projected to produce additional annual revenues in Nebraska of approximately \$7,125 and will increase applicant's Nebraska rate of retrun from 1.1% to 3.0%.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-205 be and it is hereby granted and the Western Union Telegraph Company be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.
