OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed December 23, 1981, the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska, seeks approval of a tariff sheet of its Long Distance Message Telecommunications Service Tariff.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

This application seeks to revise the tariff relating to Special Hour Discounts for Long Distance Service. This service was authorized by the Commission on a one month trial basis in Application C-152. On June 10, 1982 applicant filed a letter requesting dismissal of this application. Upon Commission dismissal of this application, the tariff sheet filed in Application No. C-152 will also be withdrawn.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be dismissed.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-214 be and it is hereby dismissed.
