OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed January 11, 1982, The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company, Lincoln, Nebraska, seeks to revise its General Exchange Tariff.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to offer a new 8 line 20 station key system and to increase rates and establish new vintages for the 1236 and 2260 key systems and the 1200 series digital switching system magnetic tape units.
