OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed January 12, 1982, the United Telephone Company of the West, Scottsbluff, Nebraska, seeks authority to revise its tariff relating to employee telephone service.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference is a copy of the following proposed tariff sheet:

Section 6, First Revised Sheet 1

Applicant proposes to revise its tariff covering discounts for employees' telephone service to increase the discount for management employees to 100% and to limit the concession to one residence oneparty line and three standard station instruments.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-221 be and it is hereby granted and the United Telephone Company of the West be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.
