OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed January 15, 1982, the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska seeks approval of a tariff sheet of its General Exchange Tariff.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

This application seeks to revise the tariff to offer operator local service from public and semi-public phones. On February 3, 1983, applicant filed a letter requesting dismissal of this application.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be dismissed at applicant's request.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-226 be and it is hereby dismissed at applicant's request.
