OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By order entered January 11, 1983 the Commission granted in part the captioned application and authorized applicant to increase rates and charges to produce additional annual revenue of \$8,032,684.

On January 21, 1983, applicant filed its Petition for Reconsideration and Rehearing. Oral argument was not requested on the motion by applicant.

Upon consideration of the application, the Petition for Reconsideration and Rehearing and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the motion should be overruled.
