OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed February 5, 1982, the Blair Telephone Company seeks authority to revise rates and charges for Local Mobile Telephone Service.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Applicant has failed to respond to a written request for cost support data for its proposed rate increases.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be dismissed for lack of prosecution.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that application No. C-232 be and it is hereby dismissed for lack of prosecution.
