OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

COMMISSIONERS CONCURRING

Service area maps were filed by the Hamilton Telephone Company, Aurora, Nebraska for its Doniphan, Nebraska exchange and by the Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company, Lincoln, Nebraska for its Hansen, Nebraska exchange which overlapped.

Since the telephone companies were unable to agree upon a boundary, the Commission, on its own motion, directed that a public hearing be held on March 22, 1982 at 9:30 a.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln, Nebraska, for the purpose of determining a boundary.

On March 12, 1982 the Commission was notified that the companies had reached an agreement which established a common boundary line between the Doniphan and Hansen exchanges.

On March 15, 1982 the Commission cancelled the hearing on this inquiry as the parties had reached a mutual agreement on a new joint boundary.

Both companies have filed new exchange boundary maps for the Doniphan and Hansen exchanges which agree upon a common boundary line.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that this inquiry is terminated and the matter is dismissed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the new boundary maps received for the Doniphan and Hansen exchanges do reflect the approved boundary between these exchange.
