OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed March 9, 1982, the Central Radiophone Company, Gothenburg, Nebraska, seeks approval of tariff and rates.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference is a copy of the proposed tariff consisting of 18 pages.

Applicant seeks to adjust existing rates for radio common carrier service at Cozad, Nebraska and to establish rates and tariffs for radio common carrier service including voice paging and two-way mobile telephone service at Curtis and Ogallala, Nebraska.

The proposed tariff will provide for uniform rates and regulations in all of applicant's service area.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-243 be and it is hereby granted and the Central Radiophone Company be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff as set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file an appropriate tariff with the Commission.
