OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed March 17, 1982, the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska, seeks authority to waive a non-recurring charge for 60 days.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Applicant proposes to conduct a promotional program to stimulate the sale of Custom Calling Services at its exchanges from May 1, 1982 to July 1, 1982 and requests authority to waive and suspend the authorized service ordering charge for Custom Calling Services installed during this period.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-246 be and it is hereby granted and the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company be and it is hereby authorized to waive service ordering charges for Custom Calling Services from May 1, 1982 to July 1, 1982.
