OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed May 26, 1982, the Nebraska Radio Telephone Systems, Grand Island, Nebraska, seeks authority to revise its tariff regarding recurring charges on paging systems at Lincoln, Nebraska.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff for paging service in Lincoln, Nebraska to establish separate rates for single address and dual address tone-only pagers and establish a flat rate of \$13.50 per month for tone and voice pager service charges instead of the present rates which are based on usage.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.
