OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed June 1, 1982, the General Telephone Company of the Midwest, Columbus, Nebraska, seeks authority to establish termination of service for cause under General Rules and Regulations in Section III of the Nebraska tariff.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference are copies of the following proposed tariff sheets:

Fourth Revised Sheet 4A

Applicant seeks to revise language in its General Rules and Regulations to provide for termination of service for non-payment, violation of regulations, use of profane language and fraudulent use of service. These provisions are presently contained in other parts of the tariff.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-262 be and it is hereby granted and the General Telephone Company of the Midwest be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file appropriate tariff sheets with the Commission.
