OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed June 14, 1982, the Continental Telephone Company of Nebraska, Wisner, Nebraska, seeks authority to revise its general services and service connection charges tariffs in Nebraska.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference are copies of the following proposed tariff sheets:

First Revised Sheet 19, Section 5 Second Revised Sheet 1, Section 6

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to indicate that the sent-paid operator-handled rate applies for Enterprise/Zenith calls and to establish a charge of \$7.00 for non-sufficient fund checks.

Consistant with the charge allowed other telephone companies, the Commission will allow a charge of \$3.00 for non-sufficient fund checks.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that as modified the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted in part.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-265 be and it is hereby granted in part and the Continental Telephone Company of Nebraska be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a charge of \$3.00 for non-sufficent fund checks be and it is hereby granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file appropriate tariff sheets with the Commission.
