## OPINION AND FINDINGS

## BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed July 9, 1982, the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska, seeks approval of a tariff sheet of its General Exchange Tariff.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. A protest to the application was filed, but later withdrawn.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference is a copy of the following proposed tariff sheet:

Seventh Revised Sheet 2, Section 37

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to allow for the waiver of the service ordering charge for Custom Calling Service. This waiver would apply during periods of special promotions and central office conversions. The tariff establishing the waiver will be effective for one year.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.
