OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed July 12, 1982, John Troester, Hampton, Nebraska, seeks authority to receive telephone service from the Hampton exchange of the Hamilton Telephone Company.

Copies of the application were served upon the Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company, and the Hamilton Telephone Company.

Applicant is an individual residing near the City of Hampton, Nebraska, receiving telephone service from the Bradshaw exchange of the Lincoln Telephone Company, who desires telephone service from the Hampton exchange of the Hamilton Telephone Company.

Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company has advised the Commission in writing that it is agreeable to the application and Hamilton Telephone Company has indicated in writing, that it is willing to provide service to the Applicant.

The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company has indicated the cost of removal and value on the unexpired life of their facilities is \$151.00. Applicant has agreed to pay for this loss of investment.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is agreeable to all parties concerned, will not create a duplication of facilities, is in the public interest, and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-278 be and it is hereby granted and John Troester be and he is hereby authorized to receive telephone service from the Hampton exchange of the Hamilton Telephone Company.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Hamilton Telephone Company and the Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company file with this Commission revised boundary maps reflecting the change in exchange service areas authorized herein.
