OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed July 13, 1982 the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska seeks approval of tariff sheets of its Long Distance Message Telecommunications Service Tariff.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Applicant sought by this application to restructure toll rates. Resconstructed toll rates were authorized by the Commission order entered January 11, 1983 in Application No. C-227.

On February 18, 1983, applicant filed a letter requesting dismissal of this application.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be dismissed at applicant's request.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-279 be and it is hereby dismissed at applicant's request.
