OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed July 29, 1982, Tracy Corporation II, Scottsbluff, Nebraska, sought authority to acquire the Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity issued to Mainline Communications.

On November 5, 1982, this application was granted and Applicant was duly notified that such action had been taken.

On October 17, 1983, Applicant notified this Commission by mail that the authorized radio common carrier services will not be provided by November 5, 1983 and Applicant requested a 12 month extension of time be granted for compliance with the authority granted in application No. C-288.

After due consideration of Applicant's request and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that Applicant's request should be granted and that the authority granted in Application No. C-288 be extended for a period of 12 months to November 5, 1984.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Applicant's request be and it is hereby granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the authority granted in Application No. C-288 be extended and that Tracy Corporation II, Scottsbluff, Nebraska, be given an extension of time to November 5, 1984 to comply with the authority granted in Application No. C-288.
