OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed July 30, 1982, the Continental Telephone Company of Nebraska, Wisner, Nebraska, seeks authority to revise its tariff.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

By letter dated October 27, 1982, applicant deleted from its filing the revision of sheet 16 of Section 5.

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to limit the offering of certain equipment to existing subscribers and to delete certain equipment offerings of which there are none in service. Limited offerings include Automatic Dialing-Equipment, Compact Telephones, Outdoor Telephones, Speakerphones and Trim Line Telephones. Discontinued items include Automatic Warning Equipment, Explosive Atmosphere Equipment, Home Interphone Service, Key Equipment Intercom Packages, Headsets and Panel Telephones.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted as amended.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-290 be and it is hereby granted as amended and the Continental Telephone Company of Nebraska be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file appropriate tariff sheets with the Commission.
