OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed October 1, 1982, the Nebraska Telephone Association, Lincoln, Nebraska seeks authority to establish depreciation rates for telephone companies.

On Nevember 3, 1982, applicant submitted a motion that the public hearing set for November 17th on the application be confined to depreciation rates for station apparatus, station connections and large PBXs. Subsequently, on November 23, 1982, the Commission granted the application in part and established new depreciation rates for those three accounts.

On July 5, 1983, the applicant submitted a letter requesting to withdraw the remainder of its application.

Upon further consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application not previously granted be dismissed at applicant's request.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-305, to the extent not granted in part on November 23, 1982, be and it is hereby dismissed at applicant's request.
