OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed October 20, 1982, the United Telephone Company of the West, Scottsbluff, Nebraska, seeks authority to file tariff sheets establishing its policy on providing carrier originating and terminating services.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. Protest to the application was filed, but subsequently withdrawn.

On April 29, 1983, applicant submitted a letter requesting to withdraw its application.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be dismissed at applicant's request.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-310 be and it is hereby dismissed at applicant's request.
