OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed November 2, 1982, the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska, seeks approval of a sheet of its General Exchange Tariff.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference is a copy of the following proposed tariff sheet:

First Revised Sheet 55, Section 41

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to add a new toll trunk to the Call Rating System tariff. This trunk routes 0+ calls to the TSPS operator and 1+ calls to Direct Distance Dialing.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-315 be and it is hereby granted and the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.
