OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed November 12, 1982, the Continental Telephone Company of Nebraska, Wisner, Nebraska, seeks authority to modify its tariff.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference is a copy of the following proposed tariff sheet:

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to make permanent the offering of residence additional lines at 80% of the primary service rate.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.
