OPINION AND FINDING

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed November 15, 1982, The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company, Lincoln, Nebraska, proposes a promotional program and seeks authorization to temporarily suspend long distance toll charges for calls of a maximum duration of three minutes each made over two B-1 lines located at East Park Plaza Shopping Center, Lincoln, Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the application and pursuant to the procedures of Section 75-121 of the Nebraska Revised Statutes, as amended, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that:

1. Applicant is a telephone company providing complete telecommunications services in the southeastern 22 counties of Nebraska and is operating under the Nebraska statutes and under the jurisdiction of this Commission.
2. Applicant proposes to offer as a promotional program during the period of November 26 through December 23, 1982, to members of the public an opportunity to place long distance toll calls within the continental United States from two B-1 lines for a maximum duration of three minutes each, such calls to be made from a booth at East Park Plaza Shopping Center, Lincoln, Nebraska.
3. Due to the shortness of time prior to the desired commencement date of such promotion, the Commission finds that an emergency exists under Section 75-121, and that the application is fair and reasonable and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that an emergency exists, and that The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company is hereby authorized to temporarily suspend long distance toll charges for calls made pursuant to the promotional program hereinabove described, such suspension to be expressly limited to such time, place and purpose described herein.
