OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed November 30, 1982, Chandler S. Lynch, DBA Midtown Business Center and Answering Service, Kearney, Nebraska seeks to transfer its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to operate as a radio common carrier.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commissions's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Pursuant to notice required by law, public hearing was held on the application on January 31, 1983 at 8:00 a.m. in the Commissioner Hearing Room, Lincoln, Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the application, the evidence adduced at the hearing and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that:

1. Applicant is a sole proprietorship with its principal place of business in Kearney, Nebraska. It is engaged in the communications business as a radio common carrier under the jurisdiction of the Commission.

2. Applicant is incorporating its business as Midtown Communications, Inc. and seeks to transfer its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to Midtown Communications, Inc.

3. There will be no actual change in management or operations as a result of this incorporation. Chandler S. Lynch will be President, Chandler S. Lynch III; Vice-President and Jean Lynch, Secretary-Treasurer.

4. The application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-326 be and it is hereby granted and Chandler S. Lynch, DBA Midtown Business Center and Answering Service be and it is hereby authorized to transfer its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to Midtown Communications, Inc.
