OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed December 8, 1982, the Consolidated Telephone Company, Lincoln, Nebraska, seeks authority to amend its Merna, Nebraska, Local Exchange Tariff.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference is a copy of the following proposed tariff sheet.

Local Exchange Tariff, Merna, Nebraska.

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff for local exchange service at Merna, Nebraska to eliminate all rates for multi-party service coincident with the upgrading of the Merna exchange to all one party service.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-328 be and it is hereby granted and the Consolidated Telephone Company be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file an appropriate tariff sheet with the Commission.
