OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By order entered June 14, 1983, the Commission granted the above-captioned application and authorized Northwestern Bell Telephone Company to revise its Wide Area Telephone Service tariff, including the authorization for resale and sharing of WATS.

Upon further consideration of the application on its own motion, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the order of June 14, 1983 should be vacated and set aside and that further hearing be scheduled on this matter for December 13, 1983 at 2:00 p.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln, Nebraska to consider the financial impact of said application upon telephone companies and such other evidence as may be appropriate.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the order entered June 14, 1983 in application No. C-331 be and it is hereby vacated and set aside and further hearing is scheduled for December 13, 1983 at 2:00 p.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln, Nebraska.
