OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By order entered June 14, 1983, the Commission granted the above-captioned application and authorized Northwestern Bell Telephone Company to revise its Wide Area Telephone Service tariff, including the authorization for resale and sharing of WATS.

A Motion for Rehearing of the application was filed by The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company, an intervenor, on June 27, 1983. Oral argument was held on the motion on September 6, 1983.

Upon further consideration of the application, the arguments of counsel and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the Motion for Rehearing should be overruled. We further find that Commission staff conduct a study of the effect of resale for a six month period and report the results thereof to the Commission.
