OPINION AND FINDING

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed December 15, 1982, the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska sought approval of tariffs restructuring WATS rates and authorizing resale and sharing of WATS facilities.

On June 14, 1983 the Commission granted the application. On October 11, 1983 the Commission reconsidered that part of the application authorizing resale of WATS and scheduled a further hearing on the matter for January 16, 1984.

On January 10, 1984, applicant filed a motion to dismiss that part of its application which would have allowed resale and sharing of WATS service.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application, as it relates to resale and sharing of WATS service, should be dismissed at applicant's request and the hearing scheduled for January 16, 1984 should be cancelled.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that application no. C-331, insofar as it pertains to resale and sharing of WATS service be and it is hereby dismissed at applicant's request.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that public hearing scheduled for January 16, 1984 be and it is hereby cancelled.
