OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed December 27, 1982, United Telephone Company of the West, Scottsbluff, Nebraska, requested authority to increase its rates and charges. A timely protest was filed by Tracy Corporation II. Protestant filed interrogatories to Applicant. On August 23, 1983, the Commission issued an order authorizing United to increase its rates and charges to produce additional revenue of \$650,149. On September 6, 1983, the Commission issued its order approving United's schedule of rates and charges.

Subsequent motions have been filed and interrogatories served on Applicant. On July 6, 1984, Applicant filed an Objection to a third set of interrogatories propounded by Tracy Corporation II.

The Commission, on July 10, 1984, considered the objection and upon consideration of the Objection, and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the Objection to the third set of Interrogatories should be sustained.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Objection to the third set of Interrogatories in Application No. C-335 be and it is hereby sustained.
