OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed December 27, 1982, United Telephone Company of the West seeks authority to increase rates.

On January 28, 1983 and on February 9, 1983, protestant Tracy Corp. II propounded interrogatories to the applicant.

On April 20, 1983 protestant filed this motion in which it indicates that applicant has failed to answer any of the interrogatories or to file objections thereto. Protestant requests that applicant be ordered to answer the interrogatories within three days, that all interrogatories be answered, and that it be awarded attorney's fees in the amount of \$500.00.

Upon consideration of the application and the motion, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the motion should be sustained in part and applicant should be ordered to file timely answers to all interrogatories with the protestant.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Motion to Compel Answers to Interrogatories in application No. C-335 be and it is hereby sustained in part and applicant be and it is hereby ordered to file timely answer to all interrogatories with the protestant.
