OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed December 30, 1982, The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company, Lincoln, Nebraska, seeks authority to restrict service to existing supply.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference is a copy of the following proposed tariff sheet:

Second Revised Sheet 4A, Section 1

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to indicate that the availability of leased terminal equipment is limited to the existing supply and that new telephone terminal equipment will not be offered under the tariff.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-342 be and it is hereby granted and The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file an appropriate tariff sheet with the Commission.
