OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed January 14, 1983, the General Telephone Company of the Midwest, Columbus, Nebraska, seeks authority to remove Time and Temperature Announcement Equipment from its Nebraska Division Tariff.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. Two protest to the application were filed but subsequently withdrawn.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference is a copy of the following proposed tariff sheet:

Fifth Revised Sheet 21, Section II

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to remove the offering of time and temperature announcement equipment. Service will be continued to existing customers until changed or discontinued at customer request.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-344 be and it is hereby granted and the General Telephone Company of the Midwest be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file an appropriate tariff sheet with the Commission.
