OPINION AND FINDINGS

By its application filed January 18, 1983, the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska, seeks approval of tariff sheets of its Private Line Tariff.

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to offer Telemetry Alarm Bridging Service (TABS), an optional private line service designed to provide one-way or two-way communications between a master station and a number of remote stations.
