OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed January 24, 1983, the Stanton Telephone Company, Stanton, Nebraska, seeks approval of new tariff sheets.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference are copies of the following proposed tariff sheets:

General Index
General Rules and Regulations, Sheets 1 - 35
General Exchange Service Tariffs, Sheets 1 - 30
Local Exchange Service Tariffs, Sheets 1 - 4
Message Toll Service Tariffs, Sheets 1 - 6

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to provide for new service features including automatic answering and recording, key systems and custom calling.

Applicant also proposes to increase the rate for local calls from pay phones to 25 cents. We find that there is not sufficient justification to increase coin telephone rates and this part of the application should be denied.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application as modified above is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted in part.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-350 be and it is hereby granted in part and the Stanton Telephone Company be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the proposed increase in pay phone rates be and it is hereby denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file appropriate tariff sheets with the Commission.
